Upon completion of the course, The National Judicial College will provide a Uniform Certificate of Attendance form to all participants from states with Mandatory CLE/CJE. The form contains the total CLE/CJE credit hours for the course, based upon the participant's state of residence. **Please note: If you need CLE/CJE credit for a state, other than the state in which you live, contact the staff members in the Registrar's Office.**

Minutes per hour are the number of minutes of class time required by the state to receive one CLE/CJE credit.

For example: A course that totals 1535 minutes of class time will total 30.70 credit hours in a 50 min./hr. state, and total 25.58 credit hours in a 60 min./hr. state.

Only actual course time is calculated into the total course minutes. Breaks, lunch, orientation, and graduation are excluded from the calculation in accordance with state CLE/CJE rules.

To receive CLE or CJE credit, contact your local CLE or CJE board at the phone number listed. You will need to provide them with the Uniform Certificate of Attendance, a copy of the course schedule, and a copy of the roster, faculty biographies and sometimes a copy of your graduation certificate. Some states also require a processing fee for you to receive your CLE credit. Each state has different requirements. Some states have both Continuing Legal Education (CLE) and Continuing Judicial Education (CJE) credit requirements. In some states, judges are exempt from reporting CLE credit.
